4th Historic Marker at 4250 GMD – describes how Longboat Key was used as a target and bombing range in WWII

5th Historic Marker at 4800 GMD at Beach Access describes the target range and USCG patrolling the beach at night

Beach Access 100 Broadway Street

6th Historic Marker at 631 Broadway describes the location of the first home built ~1862 by Thomas Mann and marks an existing home built in the early 1900s by attorney John Walters

7th Historic Marker farther down Broadway North of the present Town dock describes the covered dock located there and destroyed in hurricane of 1921. The dock was the site of ferry operations from Tampa to Sarasota via Longboat Key
